What will be instructed ...

Diagnosis and treatment of teeth diseases



How will be instructed...

The course is designed to provide a maximum of practical work and exchange of information between experienced practitioners. It starts on Saturday morning with images of daily cases provided by the instructors. On Saturday afternoon practical work on real cases will be done in the equine clinic Tillysburg. Work will be divided into three sessions of 60 minutes each. A new case will be treated by the instructors in each session, but the group of participants changes (= 9 different cases, 3 for each group); in these sessions the horses undergo the routine dental exam and treatment of an instructor.

On Sunday morning we will continue work in the clinic but on skulls to discuss findings as well as treatment options and allow for the use of the instructors (and participants) equipment for corrective procedures. All interesting findings of the real cases and skulls will be photographed and these photos will be the basis for the discussion on Sunday afternoon.

And: On Saturday we will have the surprise evening. Do not miss it!
